What to do next.....

Services available from the Exam Boards:

- **Script**

If you request your original script you will not be able to request any other post-results services e.g. a re-mark. Please discuss this option with your subject teacher before requesting your original script. You can request a copy, but this will not allow enough time for a re-mark once the script has been returned to College.

Exam Board deadline for return of original script request – **13th September 2010**

- **Clerical Check**

A clerical check does not include any re-marking but does check that the script has been fully marked, correctly totalled and recorded.

Exam Board deadline for a clerical check request – **13th September 2010**

- **Re-mark**

If you request a re-mark you must be aware that your grade may go DOWN as well as up. You will have to sign the consent form giving permission for a re-mark to be carried out.

Exam Board deadline for a re-mark request – **13th September 2010**

***Please discuss with your subject teacher the options available to you.**

***Please note that if your subject teacher does not agree that your paper should be re-marked e.g. if you are too far off the grade boundary then you will have to pay for the re-mark (between £20 and £40 dependent on the exam board). If your grade goes up as a result of the re-mark your fee will be refunded.**
