We are looking forward to welcoming your child to Summer School. This letter will detail the final arrangements for the week.

## **Dates and Times:**

Summer School runs from 15<sup>th</sup> – 19<sup>th</sup> August, 9am – 3pm each day. Please arrive promptly.

## **Transport:**

Buses are booked and paid for, there is no cost to parents for use of the buses. The times and stops are shown below. Please arrive at the bus stop at least 5 minutes prior to the expected arrival time. The buses will be marked 'Settle College Summer School'. Please do not get on the bus if you haven't requested a space – there may not be room!

### Vehicle 1 (19 seater minibus)

8.15 am – Embsay (Brackenley Lane Bus Stop)  
8.25 am – Skipton (Bus Station or St Stephen's)  
8.35 am – Gargrave (Bus Shelter)  
8.45 am – Hellifield (Black Horse)  
8.50 am – Long Preston (Opposite Maypole)

### Vehicle 2 (33 seater minicoach)

8.15 am – High Bentham (Bus Stop at the bottom of Robin Lane)  
8.25 am – Burton (Shop)  
8.35 am – Ingleton (Community Centre or New Village)  
8.40 am – Clapham (New Inn)  
8.45 am – Austwick (Bus Stop)

### Vehicle 3 (9 seater minibus)

8.35 am – Horton (Station Corner or Church Corner)  
8.45 am – Stainforth (Car Park)  
8.50 am – Langcliffe (Ellwood Cottages)

## **Arrival in school on 15<sup>th</sup> August:**

Friendly staff will be available to meet the children off the buses, and will be located around the entrances to direct those children arriving on foot. The children will be congregating at the Bradley Building. Don't worry if they don't remember where this is! They will be shown where to go.

## **Lunches:**

Children who have requested a lunch from school will have one available. All other students must bring their own packed lunch. There are picnic benches to eat at outside, where we will all eat together.

## **Attendance:**

Thank you for letting us know which days your children will be attending. If your child is unable to attend for any reason, please do phone us at 8.45am on 01729 822451. If we do not hear from you on a day we expect your child to be in Settle College, we will have to spend time phoning home and locating the child for safeguarding purposes.
