

A Level Art and Design: Fine Art Summer Project.



First Task-

I want you to create a self portrait in any media of your choice, must be at least A4 in size on any surface of your choice, but the only rule is I want the image to be distorted in some way. I have included a couple of examples on above for you to get inspiration from. You can be broken up into sections, covered up, distorted reflections, change your surroundings so they are imaginative.

You can use Pinterest to give you some interesting ideas to help you come up with something.

This can be black and white, colour, paint, pencil, collage, 3D I do not mind, but I want an image of yourself distorted in some way. You could make it personal such as Francis Bacon and Frida Kahlo.

Second Task-

Choose an artist, any artist you like that does distorted portraiture as their main theme and create a study page on them. This needs to cover at least an A3 sheet of paper or 2 A4. You should be getting with this sheet an artist/ photographer study page help sheet to help you with this.

Third Task- Optional-

Go and visit a gallery, there are lots of galleries that are free to visit. Go and visit one, take photos, do drawings from them get some inspiration, ready for when you come back.



Equipment to get over the Summer ready for your course-

At least 1 A3 sketchbook, with good quality cartridge paper in. (You might need 2 for your coursework).

You might want to get an A2 Sketchbook again with good cartridge paper in for the exam in Yr13.

Set of drawing pencils.

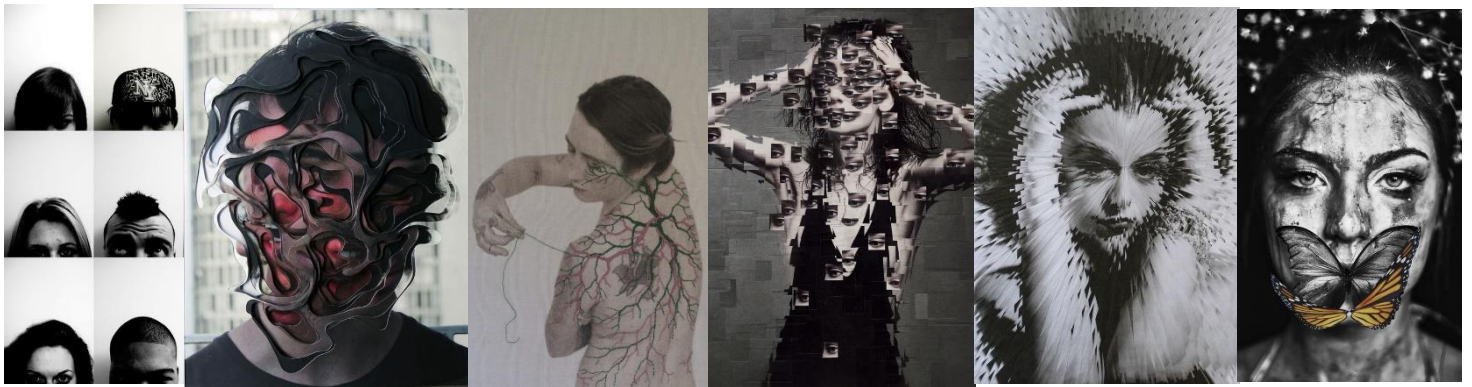
A good rubber.

First Task-

I want you to create a piece of work that is based on distorted portraits, you can do this by physically manipulating the image or you can do it digitally on a program such as PhotoPea or if you purchased it PhotoShop. This distortion could be anything from parts of faces, to layers cut out, to sewing into your image. This needs to be either a physical piece or digital that has been printed out, at least A4 in size.

You can use Pinterest to give you some interesting ideas to help you come up with something.

This can be black and white, colour, physical or digital, I do not mind, but it must be portrait that is distorted in some way. You could make it personal or imaginative.

Second Task-

Choose a photographer, any photographer you like that does distorted portraiture as their main theme and create a study page on them. This needs to cover at least an A3 sheet of paper or 2 A4 or PowerPoint slide. You should be getting with this sheet an artist/ photographer study page help sheet to help you with this.

Third Task- Optional-

Go and visit a gallery, there are lots of galleries that are free to visit. Go and visit one, take photos, do drawings from them get some inspiration, ready for when you come back.



Equipment to get over the Summer ready for your course-

You need an A3 sketchbook/ folder, you might need 2 for the whole course.

You will want a smaller one (A4) for your exam.

You want a selection of different pens (metallic, white, fine liners, biro's etc).

You might want to get a selection of equipment, such as decent scissors, glue, spray glue for at home and that you can bring in.
