

DISAPPOINTING A2 RESULTS?

What to do next.... Services available from the Exam Boards:

• Copy of Script

You can request a copy of your script so that you can decide, in consultation with your subject teacher(s), whether to apply for a mark review or a clerical re-check.

Exam Board deadline for photocopies for enquiry purposes request – 1^{st} September. Applications for scripts after this date will not be returned in time for a re-mark.

• Clerical Re-check

A clerical re-check does not include any mark review but does check that the script has been fully marked, correctly totalled and recorded.

Exam Board deadline for a clerical re-check request – **28th September 2023** Exam board target completion is within 20 calendar days of receipt of request

• Mark Review

This is a review of the original marking to ensure that the agreed mark scheme has been applied correctly – it is not a re-mark. If you request a mark review you must be aware that your grade may go DOWN as well as up. You will have to sign a consent form before this can be processed.

Exam Board deadline for a mark review request – **28th September 2023** Exam board target completion is 30 calendar days of receipt of request.

• Priority 2 Service (Review of marking – with or without a copy of the script)

This is a priority check and only available to GCE candidates whose place in further/higher education is dependent on the outcome

If you request a mark review you must be aware that your grade may go **DOWN** as well as up. You will have to sign a consent form before this can be processed. This is a clerical re-check, review of the original marking of externally assessed components and re-assessment units/components by a senior examiner.

Exam Board deadline for Priority 2 Service request – **28th September 2023** Exam board target completion is within 18 calendar days of receipt of request

Please note there will be a charge for any of these services of between £15 and £67 (dependent on exam board and service requested). All forms are available from the Exams Office. Re-sits and EARs (Enquiries about Results) must be paid for in cash or by cheque at the college Finance Office before E.A.R. requests or entries are made. If your grade goes up as a result of the mark review your fee will be refunded.

<u>Re-sit</u>

You can re-sit one or more units in June 2024. The fee will be between £15 - £24 per unit (dependent on exam board).
