



## DISAPPOINTING GCSE RESULTS?

What to do next.....

Post Results Services available from the Exam Boards:

- **Clerical Check**

A clerical check does not include any mark review but does check that the script has been fully marked, correctly totalled and recorded.

Exam Board deadline for a clerical check request – **28<sup>th</sup> September 2023**. The charge for this service will be between £8 and £12 depending on the exam board.

- **Mark Review**

This is a review of the original marking to ensure that the agreed mark scheme has been applied correctly – it is not a re-mark. If you request a mark review you must be aware that your grade may go DOWN as well as up. You will have to sign the consent form giving permission for a mark review to be carried out.

Exam Board deadline for a re-mark request – **28<sup>th</sup> September 2023**. The cost per unit/component will be between £35 and £50 depending on the exam board.

- **Access to Script**

If you request your original script you will not be able to request any other post-results services. Please discuss this with your subject teacher before requesting your original script.

Exam Board deadline for a script request – **7<sup>th</sup> September 2023**. There is no charge for this service

- **Priority 2 Service (Review of marking – with or without a copy of the script)**

**This is a priority check and only available to GCSE candidates whose place in further education is dependent on the outcome.**

If you request a mark review you must be aware that your grade may go **DOWN** as well as up. You will have to sign a consent form before this can be processed.

This is a clerical check, review of the original marking of externally assessed components and re-assessment of units/components by a senior examiner. This cost can be between £45 and £60 depending on the exam board.

Exam Board deadline for Priority 2 Service request – **28<sup>th</sup> September 2023**

Exam board target completion is within 20 calendar days of receipt of request.

*Subject Leaders and members of the Senior Leadership team will closely analyse marks achieved and look at the grade boundaries. They may recommend that you pursue a review, and the school will, on your agreement, pay for the review. If we do not think that a review is suitable, then you will have to pursue this review independently and pay the fee (between £45 and £60 dependent on the exam board).*

**Re-sits are only available for GCSE Maths and English.**

**GCSE Maths and GCSE English Language re-sits are available in November 2023.**
